Dear Parents,

I hope you had a great Christmas and are looking forward to the year ahead.

We are introducing a few changes to Kings Club, it will still have all the fun of the previous sessions but in a more structured way. Children will be grouped in ages for some of the session but will still have the opportunity to come together as a whole group for part of the evening. This way we will be able to provide more age appropriate activities. The children will also have their own group leader who they will be able to go to for whatever reason.

We have also been working on how to get your children out quicker at the end of the session as we are aware that this is often time consuming.

Children will be checked in in the usual way but will then be expected to go to their colour coded group at the beginning of the session.

At the end of the session we will ask parents to walk along the corridor and enter the worship area through the doors at the end. Please make your way to your child's group, and they will then be checked out by their group leader who will hand you a check out card. A team member will be posted on the exit. Please hand them your check out card as you leave.

This process should speed things up and ensure that each child is collected safely.

We will now be collecting payment termly. If this causes difficulty, please let us know.

This half terms' subs will be £12 for the 6 weeks per child. This includes all activities and refreshments.

Families with three or more children will only pay for the first two children.

As this is a new change, the deadline for this terms subs is January 18th.

We look forward to a fun filled term.
