We want to see young people grow present and accountable relationships with each other, with their peers and the adults around them, accepting all young people for who they are and how they act. We believe that God has a plan for every young

person and pray for them to discover that plan. Andy heads up our Youth Ministry with the direct support of Chris our student youth worker and an amazing team of volunteers!

Each week we have three main ways we serve young people at CtK:

Youth Roots is a place for young people to develop and grow in their faith, leadership skills, gifts, and abilities while being rooted in God's Word, living out their faith in Jesus wholeheartedly. Supported by mentors, prayer and leaders to discover what God can do in and through them. It takes place in Room 3 during the morning services at 9.00am and 11.00 am every Sunday during term time. It's for young people in secondary school.

As young people mature in their faith they are encouraged to find a place to serve within the wider church family, often on a Sunday Morning in children's groups, reading, the welcome team, the audio-visual team, and many other areas.

Friday Youth we hope is a safe, fun, and energetic space with games, activities and trips that help young people develop stronger relationships and to build trust, understanding and respect of others.

Meeting weekly during term time from 7.15pm to 8.45pm for secondary school aged young people.

After Hour is a time for young people to explore faith, the issues and the challenges that they face each day. It happens after Friday Youth at 8.45pm until 9.45pm, weekly during term time.

Four Twelve meets weekly on a Sunday night at 6.30pm until 8.00pm (ish) to Beginning in worship together, engaging with the Bible, Praying for each other and trying to understand more about how to form a strong faith and Gods plans.

Through all we do we want to encourage young people to not let anyone look down on them, but to set an example to others in speech, in conduct, in love, and in Faith (1 Timothy 4.12).
